

Text inside a shape

Using the type tool, write a word. You may change the font and size by opening the *character* window. Either click *window>type>character* or press Control+T.

For this lesson, I used Arial Black in a 72 point size. Bold fonts tend to work best.

Using the pen tool or another vector shape tool, draw your shape. Make sure that your



shape has no fill.

Once these two elements are in place, select everything on your art board. You can use the selection tool to do this, or you can go to *select>all*. (Control+A)

Go to *object>envelope distort>make with top object*

If it doesn't work, you may have your layers reversed.

Make sure the layers are in the right order
